A STORY FROM SAI SATCHARITRA

Once, Kaka Mahajani went to Shirdi from Bombay. He wanted to stay there for one week, and enjoy the Gokul-Ashtami festival. As soon as he took Baba's darshan, Baba asked him - "When are you returning home?" He was rather surprised at this question, but he had to given an answer. He said that he would go home when Baba ordered him to do so. Then Baba said - "Go to-morrow". Baba's word was law and had to be obeyed. Kaka Mahajani, therefore, left Shirdi, immediately. When he went to his office in Bombay, he found that his employer was anxiously waiting for him. His munim, i.e., the manager, suddenly fell ill, hence Kaka's presence was absolutely necessary. He had sent a letter to Kaka at Shirdi, which was redirected to him at Bombay.

Bhausaheb Dhumal

Now listen to an opposite story. Once Bhausaheb Dhumal, a pleader, was going to Niphad for a case. On the way he came to Shirdi, took Baba's darshan and wanted to proceed to Niphad immediately. But, Baba did not premit him to do so. He made him stay at shirdi, for a week or more. In the meanwhile, the magistrate at Niphad suffered intensely from pain in his abdomen, and the case was adjourned. Mr. Dhumal was then allowed to go and attend to his case. It went on for some months and was tried by four magistrates. Ultimately Mr. Dhumal won the case, and his client was acquitted.

Mrs. Nimonkar

Mr. Nanasaheb Nimonkar, Watandar of Nomon and Honorary Magistrate, was staying at Shirdi with his wife. Mr. and Mrs. Nimonkar were spending most of their time in the Masjid with Baba and serving Him. It so happened, that their son fell ill at Belapur and the mother decided, with Baba's consent, to go to Belapur, and see her son and other relatives; and stay there for a few days, but Mr. Nanasaheb asked her to return the next day. The lady was in a fix and did not know what to do; but her God Sai came to her help. While leaving Shirdi she went to Baba, who was standing in front of Sathe's wada with Mr. Nanasaheb and others, and prostrated at His Feet and asked His permission to go. Baba said to her, "Go, go quickly, be calm and unperturbed. Stay comfortably at Belapur for four days. See all your relatives and then return to Shirdi." How opportune were Baba's words! Mr. Nanasaheb's proposal was overruled by Baba's decree.





DEVOTEE'S EXPERIENCEMAHALAYA PAKSHAM

It was Sri Viswavasu Nama Samvatsaram, Dvadasi on the 12th day of Pitru Paksham. As dawn approached, the temple priests were immersed in Pitru rituals, having begun the sacred prayers during Brahma Muhurtam. Devotees, too, were deeply engaged, chanting, meditating, and absorbing the serene beauty of the temple surroundings. Around 4:00 AM, as the prayers intensified, an unusual presence stirred quiet wonder.

A dog emerged from the nearby woods and calmly entered the temple grounds, settling among the devotees. It had no leash, no signs of ownership, and had somehow crossed the fenced compound, raising gentle questions in the minds of those present. How did it come? Why here?

Unfazed by the mystery, the Shaligram Abhishekam continued uninterrupted. The dog, seemingly drawn by a force beyond the ordinary, made a few gentle attempts to step into the sanctum sanctorum of the Bhairava Kshetram, where Pitru rituals were being performed to the sacred Shaligram by Mama (Pandit Rajagopalan). Someone offered it milk, and it settled down peacefully—no barking, no restlessness. Perhaps it, too, was in silent devotion.

As the prayers concluded, devotees began their pradakshina around the Bhairava Kshetram. To everyone's amazement, the dog—now affectionately regarded as Bhairava—joined the circumambulation, walking alongside the devotees in reverent silence. Was it a coincidence? Or a quiet miracle reminding us that divinity transcends form? After the rituals, devotees departed for their homes. But our guest, Bhairava, had only one destination—the main Sai temple. There, Babu garu welcomed him with food and contemplated adopting him into the temple family.

However, local regulations required that any stray animal be reported to Animal Control within 48 hours. The temple complied, and Bhairava was taken to the shelter. We hoped his rightful owner would come forward. But time was short. If no one claimed or adopted him within ten days, shelter policy mandated euthanasia to prevent overcrowding shelter. The next day, the owner reached out to the authorities, and we learned the Bhairava's name is Buddy - a close friend to all of us!

Meanwhile, to our shock and disbelief, the shelter diagnosed Bhairava with advanced prostate cancer. Before the owner could arrive on the next day to collect his Buddy at the shelter, Bhairava quietly slipped into eternal rest—no pain, no struggle on Chaturdashi 14th day of Pitru Paksham. The authorities informed us that it was a peaceful sleep. It was as if he had come to fulfill a final purpose, to be among the prayers, the rituals, and the devotion of Pitru Paksham. He returned to his Pitrus in peace.

Now, a few questions linger in our hearts: Why did Bhairava come to the temple? Why did he attempt to enter the sanctum sanctorum of Bhairava Kshetram? Did he know this was his final resting place? Was he sent in this form, pleased by the devotion of the devotees?



Answers to these mysteries may only be known to our master, Sridhar Guruji, or to Lord Bhairava himself. As humble seekers, we do not chase logic or reason. We simply bow our heads and pray to Lord Bhairava for blessings during this sacred Pitru Paksham. Event details were lovingly shared by a few devoted participants, Mama and Babu garu. I am grateful for the opportunity to narrate this quiet miracle that unfolded at Richmond Sai Temple Bhairava Kshetram.
